Imagine a better world. One where every person on the planet has a roof over their head and 3 square meals in their bellies every day. A world where we are making significant positive strides towards reversing the climate situation. A world where all people are truly equal.

Jae Sabol, the creator and Executive Director of One Community, has been imagining how to accomplish this for a very long time. Since 2010, along with more than 400 volunteers, he has been taking steps to really do something about this. Based in San Gabriel, CA, the group has built an entire platform aimed at demonstrating a better way of moving forward for humanity. They call it creating and building 'FOR THE HIGHEST GOOD OF ALL®' This is not something they take lightly. When you see the great detail they have gone to, it is self-evident that this is a plan *which will happen*.

The plan is to build the first One Community on a parcel of land in the southwestern United States and to demonstrate to all how it is 'easy enough, affordable enough and attractive enough to spread on its own.' Everything necessary to replicate this first community is being open sourced and free-shared, aimed at helping others who want to live in similar sustainable communities. By duplicating the entire community or any part thereof, they will help spread the models globally.

The program is all-inclusive and includes plans for creation of 7 complete 'villages'. When complete, One Community will house an estimated 1000 people, include complete food production, an entire education program for those from pre-k to grade 12 as well as adults, energy self-sufficiency, economic programs in the for-profit and non-profit sectors, as well programs in all other areas deemed to be essential to foster a much better quality of life for community members.

With a plan to double in size every year, it is possible that by the 2050, every person in the world - a full ten billion - will be touched by the program. The diversity of components of the project are designed to provide a perfect fit for even the most economically disadvantaged areas of the world.

Jae sees the project as being approximately 2 years away from being ready to put the shovel in the ground for the first construction. In the initial 4-5 years on site, the plans are to build the 2 first villages ([Earthbag](#) and [Straw Bale](#) Villages) as well as the [Duplicable City Center](#), to have 150-200 full-time residents as well as the capacity to host 100's of visitors.
